WANTED: A FEW BRAVE SOULS

TRUTH BASICS

- 1. God and His Word are the source of all TRUTH. The truth begins and ends with God; God must be the starting point in any search for the truth.
 - 2. The Bible is God's revealed Word in WRITTEN form; Jesus is God's revealed truth made flesh.
 - 3. We are all born with a natural AVERSION to the truth.
- 4. God's truth is revealed in nature, in His written Word, in the work and person of His Son and through the working of His Holy Spirit.
 - 5. Only God's Spirit can break down our RESISTANCE to God's truth.
 - 6. Jesus is the sum total of REDEMPTION truth.
- 7. Jesus is the GATEWAY to all other truth; that is, we are incapable of understanding or receiving the rest of God's truth until we have entered into a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as our Savior and Lord.

CHARACTERISTICS OF TRUTH TELLERS

- 1. They have a passionate and uncompromising LOVE for God and the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - 2. They implicitly believe God's Word in its entirety from COVER to COVER.
 - 3. They make no apologies for SIN.
 - 4. They proclaim God's truth BOLDLY and without partiality.
 - 5. They are not intimidated by the reactions or opinions of others.
 - 6. They understand that in order to make a difference they have TO BE different.
- 7. They understand what is at STAKE and are willing to pay the PRICE to stand for what is right.
- 8. Their affections are on things above, not the things here and now—they have an eternal MINDSET.
 - 9. They back their BELIEFS with ACTIONS.
 - 10. They CARE ABOUT people.

THEY ARE NOT:

- 1. Always POPULAR.
- 2. Always UNDERSTOOD.
- 3. Without their CRITICS.
- 4. Without FAULTS of their own (therefore humility is in order).
 - 5. WASTING their TIME or laboring in VAIN.
- 6. To be FOUND on every street corner or even in many CHURCHES.
 - 7. UNKNOWN to their LORD.
